In addition to this application, you will need to submit the following core application materials online using the ORMatch Application Service:

1. Your resume or curriculum vitae
 - Education (institution, dates (month and year), major, degree or pending degree, and grade point average)
 - List of Honors, Awards
 - Professional Memberships
 - Research Projects and Publications
 - Special Presentations, Seminars and Teaching Experience
 - Employment - Include Dates (month and year)
 - Community Service
 - Other Professional Experiences

2. Statement of Intent
 - Why you are interested in pursuing a residency.
 - What you hope to gain from a residency.
 - What your plans are after you complete a residency.

3. Three letters of recommendation. These letters should be from individuals who can assess your clinical performance, scholastic abilities and/or teaching and research potential. Recommendation letters must be signed on letterhead and uploaded directly from your reference to ORMatch. ORMatch will send a link to your reference. Letters must be uploaded to ORMatch by interview date or Jan. 31st at 5:00 pm whichever comes first.

4. An ***official*** copy of your optometry school transcripts directly from your school.

5. Please provide an unofficial copy of your NBEO part I, II, III and TMOD scores. Must be on NBEO Letterhead. Provide the page showing your name and all scores. ORMatch will send an official copy on your behalf. Successful completion of Part I, II, III and TMOD NBEO examinations is required to enter all NSUOCO affiliated residencies.

Once you submit an application to ORMatch, the residency and Director Residencies will have access to your application information immediately. Submitted applications cannot be changed or withdrawn. The residency supervisor will review your file and may choose to offer you an interview. Each applicant is strongly encouraged to arrange an interview at the residency site to which they are applying if an interview is offered. This allows the applicant to become more familiar with the residency site and the residency site supervisor to become familiar with the applicant. NSUOCO interviews for Family Practice, Cornea and Contact Lens, Ocular Disease / Low Vision Rehabilitation residencies will have two interview dates.

Interview dates are only Monday, January 18, 2021 and Saturday, February 20, 2021

Number of interviews per day will be limited.

All application materials should be submitted to OrMatch.
