Residency Curriculum

The educational objectives, learning activities, and expected outcomes of the Residency in Primary Eye Care and Ocular Disease include:

- 1. Provision of optometric care to a large and diverse number of patients at the CREC with an emphasis in primary eye care and ocular disease.
- 2. Appropriate referral and co-management of patients with other health care providers. External site visits may be arranged if likely to enhance expertise.
- 3. Lecture and workshop presentations in the form of continuing education, grand rounds, optometry classroom, etc.
- 4. Participation in residency seminar activities, including literature review, journal club, and case presentations.
- 5. Attendance of continuing education courses.
- 6. Completion of a research paper, literature review, or case report of publishable quality.
- 7. Active involvement in the optometric community through membership and participation in optometric organizations.
