Curriculum

Curriculum: The educational objectives, learning activities, and expected outcomes of the Residency in Ocular Disease and Refractive and Ocular Surgery include:

1. Provision of optometric care to a large number and diversity of patients at Triad Eye Medical Clinic and the Oklahoma College of Optometry at Northeastern State University Campus/hospital clinics.
2. Appropriate referral and co-management of patients with optometric physicians and other health care disciplines. External rotations may be arranged to enhance expertise in ocular disease.
3. Clinical supervision and education of optometry students at Triad and at NSUOCO.
4. Provide lecture and workshop presentations in the form of continuing education, grand rounds, optometry classroom, etc.
5. Participation in residency seminar activities, including literature review, journal club, and grand rounds.
6. Require attendance of continuing education courses to satisfy Oklahoma licensure requirements at a minimum.
