## **Welcome to the Lesley L. Walls Vision Center**

Thank you for accepting your eye doctor's recommendation that you see us for assistance with the vision problems you've been struggling with. We thought it would be a good idea to give you some information about our services, so you know what to expect.

**Optometric Low Vision Services:** During this evaluation, a history will be taken to learn the specific tasks you've been having difficulty with. Your vision then will be comprehensively assessed to determine your current visual potential. Finally, you will be evaluated for strategies that will help you achieve your goals, using the vision you have. We won't spend a lot of time evaluating the health of your eyes and we rarely dilate pupils, because your referring eye doctor is taking care of that.

For most people, major medical insurance covers our services, but the portion of the examination where your eyeglass prescription is determined is not typically a covered service. The specialty glasses and devices we prescribe are not usually covered by insurance, but may be covered if you have a vision plan, such as VSP. So, be sure to inform us if you have such a plan. **Rehabilitative Services:** Thanks to our partnership with NewView Oklahoma, patients who qualify can experience a wide range of services, usually provided in the home, that can help you accomplish your goals. A few examples include

- Learning to use your devices more effectively
- Lighting recommendations, based on your vision, to perform specific tasks
- Developing better mobility skills that improve independence and reduce your risk of falls
- Improving your ability to utilize technology
- Evaluating low vision aids in your home to help with daily tasks

NewView Oklahoma's services are typically covered by insurance, but that will be determined in advance of any provision of services.

By providing a full spectrum of services to assist people with vision loss, we can achieve much greater success in helping people who are referred to us.

The optometric services are provided through the College of Optometry at Northeastern State University. NewView Oklahoma is a non-profit organization dedicated to assisting people with visual impairment. Both are committed to providing excellent care for all individuals.
